Then YOU should be buying grocery certificates at St. Luke's!

How does it work?

1. Purchase Certificates in \$10 and \$25 amounts.
2. Buy groceries and other items at one of the participating stores and pay for them with your certificates.

Can it help St. Luke's?

YES! Buy certificates at face value and 5% or 10% of your purchase goes to reduction of our debt. The retailer makes the contribution, not you!

Where do I get my certificates?

After the 8:00am, 9:30am and before the 11:00am services near the entry of the sanctuary. You can also purchase certificates weekdays in the church office. If you have any questions, stop by the table in the narthex.

Or you can sign up to purchase your grocery certificates via electronic funds transfer (EFT).... It's easy:

1. Fill out an EFT form (available in the church office or ask Dave Cupp.)
2. Attach cancelled check to EFT form.
3. Specify on form how much money and on what date(s) you want money deducted from your checking account. (For example, \$100 on the 1st of each month, or \$50 on the 1st and 15th of each month.)
4. Money is deducted from your checking account on specified date(s).
5. Pick up your grocery certificate at St. Luke's on or after the withdrawal date.

Sign up for EFT and get a free \$25 grocery certificate!
