"Journey to Palm Sunday & Holy Week"

We have arrived at Holy Week! Today, (Palm Sunday) we celebrate, waving palms and cheering as Jesus enters into Jerusalem. The religious leaders were angry and afraid of the attention He received. The next day one of His disciplines betrays him to the leaders for money. On Thursday, (Maundy Thursday) Jesus will gather his disciples for a Passover meal referred to as The Last Supper. Jesus taught his friends many things on that night, to love one another and how to stay close if Jesus should leave them. After dinner they walk into the Garden filled with olive trees. Jesus goes off by himself to pray. Later, Jesus is arrested by soldiers for pretending to be a King. On Friday, (Good Friday) The soldiers make a crown of thorns and make him wear it. They make Jesus carry a heavy wooden cross. They put him on the cross and the world grew dark, as if a terrible thunderstorm was coming. It was as if all of creation was crying. Jesus prayed to God and God was with Him. After His death Jesus is placed in a tomb. Several days later, just before the sun comes up, 4 women go to the tomb to rub oil and spices on Jesus body. They had one last job to do, one final tribute to Jesus. They arrive at the tomb to see the boulder in front of the tomb had been moved. The tomb was empty!
